Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. Students should make both first and second choices on their registration form. Every effort will be made to accommodate the student's first or second choice.

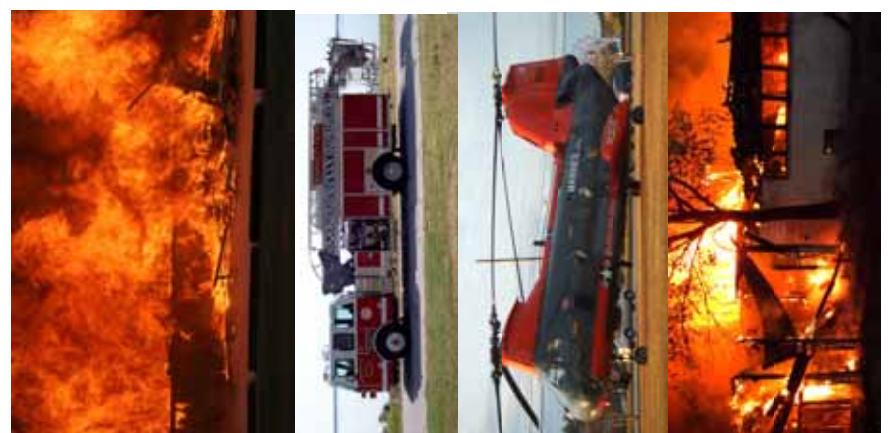

### COURSE DESCRIPTION

#### Section 01 - NC Firefighter I/II – PPE.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Firefighter I/II – PPE. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.  
Instructor: **NC Fire/Rescue Instructor**

#### Section 02 – NC Firefighter I/II – Salvage & Overhaul.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Firefighter I/II – Salvage & Overhaul Certification. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.  
Instructor: **NC Fire/Rescue Instructor**

#### Section 03 - NC Firefighter I/II – Fire Prevention, Education & Cause.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Firefighter I/II – Fire Prevention, Education & Cause. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.

#### Section 04 - NC Firefighter I/II – Building Construction & Fire Behavior

This class will meet the requirements for NC Firefighter I/II – FD Orientation & Safety. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.  
Instructor: **S. Marsh**

#### Section 05 - NC Hazardous Materials Awareness.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Hazardous Materials Awareness. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.

#### Section 06 - RT General- Ropes - Anchors & Lowers

This class will meet the requirements for NC RT General- Ropes - Anchors & Lowers Certification. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.

Instructor: **S. Williamson**

#### Section 07 - NC Driver Operator – Intro to Pumps.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Driver Operator – Intro to Pumps Certification. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.

Instructor: **NC Fire/Rescue Instructor**

#### Section 08 - NC Aerial Operator – Intro to Aerials.

This class will meet the requirements for NC Aerial Operator – Intro to Aerials Certification. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification.

Instructor: **S. Lee**

#### Section 09 – Emergency Vehicle Driver

This class will cover the safe operation of emergency vehicles, driving skills, legal implications of emergency driving and departmental standard operating procedures. Students must pass the practical(s) and written exam with a score of 70% or above in order to receive certification. This class will start Friday 7:00 PM

### Specialty

#### Section 10 - ISO—UNDERSTANDING THE NC RESPONSE RATING PLAN (12 Hours)

This class will meet Saturday, 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM and Sunday 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This class will review all of the latest information and factors which go into the make-up of the Public Protection Rating for cities and rural fire districts. It is intended for those persons interested in improving and/or maintaining the Fire Department's Public Protection Rating, which possibly could result in lowering insurance premiums for property owners.

#### Section 11 – NC Fire Inspector Upgrade

This six hour course is designed to give fire inspectors a refreshed look at all aspects of the NC Fire Code. Student must come with their own copy of the 2006 or 2009 NC Fire Code manual. Student must also have their ID number from DOI to ensure recertification.

#### Section 12 – Unarmed Self Defense for Fire/EMS

CONFIDENCE. COURAGE. EMPOWERMENT. That's what this self-defense class will provide for you. Aside from learning safety, in this course you will learn the most efficient and surprisingly effective techniques for defending yourself. The training is simple and the scenarios are realistic. NOTE: Dress in comfortable clothes (t-shirts, shorts, sweats).

#### Section 13 - Safety & Survival for Firefighters

This class is designed for firefighters with a good understanding of SCBA's and basic fire ground operations. Class will be mostly hands-on and focuses on self rescue concepts and practices as well as operating as part of a Rapid Intervention Crew. Student must come with full turnout gear & SCBA.

#### Section 14 - NFA Strategies & Tactics for Initial Company Operations (12 hours)

This course is designed to help meet the needs of company officers responsible for managing the operations of one or more companies during structural firefighting operations. STICO is designed to develop the management skills needed by company officers to accomplish assigned tactics at structure fires.

#### Section 15 – MAFTD (Mobile Aircraft Fire Trainer Device)

The MAFTD is a mobile, 40 ft aircraft simulator that enables firefighting personnel to train as aircraft firefighters in a safe environment using propane instead of hydrocarbon fuel. The MAFTD allows personnel to fight controlled fires that simulate a burning aircraft such as engine fires, brake and wheel fires, as well as interior and cargo fires. The training provided by the MAFTD team would be most useful for professional and volunteer fire department personnel whose response areas include airports or who typically have aircraft cross their airspace. Turnout gear & SCBA required. Students must have a copy of NFA form 1582-physical form with them.

#### Section 16 - Heavy Truck & Bus Extrication

This class will cover the anatomy and extrication on large vehicles such as trucks and buses. Practical stations that emphasize good stabilization techniques and lifting techniques will be covered by the students. A practical exercise will be conducted on the last day to allow the students to apply what they have learned and challenge their abilities. Equipment: Students should have; helmet, gloves, eye protection, boots and proper PPE. Students not having the proper equipment may not be allowed to participate in any of the practical work. Starts Friday at 7pm

#### Section 17 - ACLS Recertification

The AHA ACLS recert course is designed for healthcare provider who either direct or participate in resuscitation of a patient, either in or out of the hospital. Pre-requisites: 1. Must have taken two full 16 hour classes with an above marginal pass. 2. Current BLS CPR card 3. Current ACLS Student Handbook 4. Completed ACLS Pre-test 5. Applicable card fee (\$2.75)

#### Section 18 - PALS Recertification

Current BLS CPR Card 3. Current PALS Student Handbook 4. Completed PALS Pre-test 5. Applicable card fee (\$2.75)
